

MOUNTWOOD PARK HORSE CAMP RULES

1. Must sign release of liability waiver (available in mailbox) before you ride & put it in collection box located by the Sugarbush Barn.
2. Pay a \$3.00 bridle fee for day riding (not required if camping). Must contact Mountwood Park during business hours Mon thru Fri 9:00 – 4:00 pm to make arrangements to stay at the horse camp; 304-588-1407.
3. No riding during hunting season (except on Sundays).
4. No horse riding on bicycle trails; only ride designated trails and county roads.
5. Pack out what you pack in; leave the area cleaner than you found it.
6. Clean up horse manure at your area; including blacktop, tie line and stalls (if you use one) spread/scatter in Non-grazing areas and Non-mowing areas (scatter it in the woods or the steep banks, Don't leave it in big piles).
7. Put stall gates back up once your finished using them (to keep gates nice and from bowing).
8. Campfires in burn rings only (no fires on blacktop).
9. Extinguish campfires before leaving.
10. Take all trash to dumpster on your way out. (Raccoon problems if we don't).
11. Dogs may be requested to be put on a leash.
12. Laminated trail maps available for \$10.00 at Mountwood Park Administration Building.
13. Fill out a pay envelope (available in mailbox) & place it containing the fees in the COLLECTION BOX located by stalls 9 – 12 (Sugarbush barn).

DAY RIDING FEES

\$3.00 a day per person

\$20.00 passes for the season (May 1 to November 1)

Available at Mountwood Park Administration building

CAMPING FEES:

\$10.00 per night Primitive

\$15.00 per night Electric

\$10.00 a night per Stall
